- The first Brokerage/partnering event of the Health NCP Net project was held on June 17, 2008 in Krakow Poland. This event was co sponsored by two Framework Program projects: SMEs-Go-Health and Health NCP-Net.
- The event was heavily promoted by both the Health-NCP-Net partners and the SMEs-Go-Health consortium. It aimed at bringing companies and research institutes from European countries together in one place. The three pillars of the FP7 Health theme were covered.
